PETITIONER'S AMENDED PROPOSED PROPERTY DIVISION

Petitioner files this Amended Proposed Property Division and would respectfully show the Court:

1. This Amended Proposed Property Division updates the prior proposed division filed July 2025.
2. Petitioner does not seek affirmative monetary recovery from Respondent and requests entry of a final decree of divorce consistent with the items below.
3. Petitioner requests confirmation of her separate property as reflected in her Feb 2026 updated Inventory and Appraisal, including all accounts established prior to marriage and documented through financial statements provided to the Court.
4. In adherence with the 254th Court's January 2025 Order that each Party shall pay their own expenses without exception from that time forward, and additionally in line with the 302nd Court's Jan 2026 review and upholding of the same Order:

Petitioner will pay her own credit card current balances currently outstanding. Respondent will pay his own credit cards currently outstanding in his name.

Petitioner seeks no reimbursement for insurance premiums paid January 2025 and forward on behalf of the Respondent to date, and releases the Respondent from any future obligation.


5. Petitioner will pay the remaining community debt "Sofi loan" in her name of approximately \$13k, which is the last of the community debt known to the Petitioner. This additionally releases both Respondent and Petitioner from any additional and/or unnamed debts incurred by the opposing party.

6. Petitioner's exclusive and immediate control of the HSA/FSA account in her name, and revocation of the Respondent's access to that account.

6. No domain names or email addresses referencing the opposing party will be owned by either party, specifically but not limited to those currently owned by the Respondent via Ionos company. Those currently owned domain names and addresses will be relinquished and proof of such action sent to a neutral Third Party _____ within three days.

8. Confirmation that Respondent's access to Petitioner's employer-sponsored health insurance and benefits plan will expire February 24, 2026 in accordance with the Plan. This further serves to confirm that the Respondent was notified of this expiration date in email provided by Petitioner's Human Resources Dept. , served on the Respondent as part of the Notice of Compliance filed December 2025 with the clerk of court.
