PROCEDURAL MISCONDUCT & OBSTRUCTION**

**[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING LIMITED REOPENING OF DISCOVERY**

On this day, the Court considered Petitioner Jason McKemie’s Motion to Reopen Discovery.

After reviewing the motion and applicable law, the Court finds that good cause exists to reopen the discovery period due to withheld disclosures, newly available evidence, and procedural misconduct during the prior discovery window.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:**

1. Discovery in this matter is reopened for the limited purpose of:
  - a. Obtaining unredacted financial documents and account statements.
  - b. Compelling production of withheld correspondence or communications.
  - c. Subpoenaing witnesses and documents relevant to claims of perjury or procedural abuse.
2. The limited discovery period shall remain open until \_\_\_\_\_.
3. No other general discovery shall be permitted unless specifically authorized by the Court.
4. All parties shall comply with Tex. R. Civ. P. 192.3–215.2 and produce all responsive materials in good faith.
