**FINDING OF FACT AND FRAUD UPON THE COURT**

**[PROPOSED] ORDER FOR SANCTIONS AND RELIEF RELATED TO FRAUD UPON THE COURT**

On this day, the Court considered Petitioner Jason McKemie’s motion addressing coordinated acts of perjury, false testimony, and fraud upon the Court.

After reviewing the motion, accompanying exhibits, and the full record, the Court hereby makes the following findings of fact and orders:

**IT IS FOUND AND ORDERED that:**

1. The Court finds, as a matter of fact, that **\*\*Respondent, Gwendolyn Ulijasz-McKemie, and non-party witness, Pamela Woodman, each committed aggravated perjury\*\*** during these proceedings by knowingly offering materially false testimony under oath, with intent to mislead the Court.
2. The Court further finds that the **\*\*false testimony of Gwendolyn Ulijasz-McKemie and Pamela Woodman was coordinated in advance\*\***, entered in support of a fraudulent protective order and litigation advantage, and constitutes a knowing and willful attempt to subvert the judicial process.
3. As a result, the **\*\*testimony of Pamela Woodman is hereby stricken from the record in its entirety\*\***, and the Court may disregard any testimony from Respondent given under oath on the matters identified in the record as false.
4. The Court finds that this conduct constitutes **\*\*fraud upon the Court\*\*** and warrants sanctions.
5. The Court reserves the right to impose additional sanctions, issue a referral to appropriate law enforcement or disciplinary authorities, and/or limit future admissibility of testimony or evidence obtained or offered through this fraud.
