PROPOSED ORDER FOR EMERGENCY FINANCIAL RELIEF AND RELATED REQUESTS

PROPOSED ORDER GRANTING EMERGENCY RELIEF AND RELATED REQUESTS

On this day, the Court considered Petitioner’s Emergency Motion for Temporary Relief and Related Orders. After reviewing the motion and supporting materials, the Court finds that good cause exists to grant the requested relief in whole or in part, in the interest of justice and to preserve the integrity of the proceedings.

1. Automatic monetary sanctions in the amount of **\$10,000** if Respondent fails to provide both the full financial relief requested and functional HSA card credentials within **24 hours** of the Court’s order; and an additional **\$20,000** sanction if Respondent fails to comply within **48 hours**, for a total of **\$30,000 in sanctions** for continued obstruction and noncompliance.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Temporary Financial Support

Respondent shall provide immediate temporary financial support to Petitioner in the amount previously requested and reflected in the amount of \$10,500

2. Automatic sanctions if not paid within 24 hours.

Automatic \$10,000 in additional support awarded if not paid on or by June 2nd, 2025.

3. Overdue Rent / Housing Costs

Respondent shall either satisfy the overdue rent on the shared residence or transfer sufficient funds to Petitioner through the joint checking account to cover the past-due amount in full.

4. Emergency Access Protections

Respondent is hereby prohibited from obstructing Petitioner's access to healthcare, prescriptions, or any shared financial resources, including but not limited to the marital HSA card, joint bank accounts, or reimbursement mechanisms.

5. Continuance Granted

This matter is hereby continued to allow Petitioner time to stabilize his housing and medical condition, retain counsel, and meaningfully respond to pending filings and discovery.

6. Enforcement of Standing Orders

All existing Standing Orders of the Court remain in full force and effect and shall be strictly enforced. Any continued violations may subject the offending party to further sanctions.

7. Protection Against Procedural Interference

The Court hereby prohibits any further procedural gamesmanship or coordinated legal actions designed to prevent Petitioner's full and fair participation in these proceedings.

8. Hearing Scheduled

A hearing shall be scheduled at the earliest available date to address unresolved issues related to:

- o Spousal support
- o Legal fees
- o Reimbursement and payoff of marital debt

9. Sanctions Reserved

- The Court reserves the right to issue sanctions against either party upon further review of conduct, including but not limited to the use of false or misleading testimony, obstruction of access, and bad faith litigation tactics.
- o *Money awarded for relief is not a credit against what Respondent already owes in retroactive or future spousal support*
- o *The amount paid is classified as a sanction or emergency relief, not support credit*
