PROPOSED ORDER FOR DE NOVO REVIEW and TRO

FILED UNDER SEAL *FOR IN CAMERA REVIEW*

On this day, the Court considered Respondent's **Motion for De Novo District Judge Review** under Texas Family Code §201.015 and his **Emergency Application for Temporary Restraining Order**. The Court finds that immediate and irreparable harm to the community estate exists and that issuance of a Temporary Restraining Order is necessary **without hearing** to preserve the status quo pending full District Judge review.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

I. De Novo Review – Hearing to Be Set

A **De Novo hearing** shall be set before the District Judge on the following matters:

1. The ruling permitting withdrawal of Petitioner's counsel;
2. The rulings denying Respondent access to emergency marital funds necessary to preserve employment, housing, vehicle, and medical access;
3. The rulings denying reinstatement of legitimate marital transactions that were wrongfully reversed or reported as fraud.

The Court Coordinator shall set this hearing at the earliest available date.

II. Temporary Restraining Order – Immediate Effect

Petitioner is **immediately restrained and enjoined** from:

1. **Transferring, withdrawing, spending, dissipating, concealing, assigning, encumbering, or disposing of any community funds** in any account in her name or under her control, including but not limited to the **second \$150,000 installment of Petitioner's sign-on bonus**, which Petitioner's prior counsel acknowledged in mediation should be allocated to Respondent due to Petitioner retaining 100% of the first installment;
2. **Making any transfers, withdrawals, payments, or expenditures exceeding \$100**, except for ordinary food and basic personal necessities;
3. Opening new financial accounts or moving funds between existing accounts;
4. Paying legal fees, paying down debts, or making extraordinary purchases exceeding \$100.

III. Duration of TRO

This Temporary Restraining Order shall remain in effect **until further order of the District Judge** following the De Novo hearing.

IV. Routing Instruction

The Clerk of the Court **SHALL** route this Order, the underlying motion, and all related filings **directly to the District Judge** pursuant to Texas Family Code §201.015.

This filing is **not subject to associate judge referral**.
