**[PROPOSED] ORDER ON MOTION TO COMPEL DISCOVERY AND REQUEST FOR SANCTIONS**

On this day, the Court considered Petitioner Jason McKemie’s **Motion to Compel Discovery and Request for Sanctions**.

After reviewing the motion, attached exhibits, and applicable law, the Court finds that Respondent has failed to comply with prior discovery obligations, has obstructed the timely exchange of material documents, and has engaged in conduct constituting discovery abuse under **Tex. R. Civ. P. 215.2**

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:**

1. Respondent shall provide full and unredacted discovery responses, including account statements, financial documents, and all requested disclosures within **7 days** of this order.
2. As a sanction for discovery abuse and failure to comply with prior court orders, Respondent shall pay \$ \_\_\_\_\_ **in monetary sanctions** to Petitioner.
